

Hello everyone! So, we have to write down a few “rules”. We are going to open slow to make sure we are keeping everyone safe. Please be patient with us and remember that this is new for all of us, and far from the way we would normally open our doors.

General “Rules”

- Respect each others space – this means you must always keep a pin length distance from anyone who lives outside of your household.
- For now, our clubhouse is not accessible to the public. Washrooms are available in the parking lot and on the golf course.
- Do not remove pins.
- Please do not loiter in the parking lot.
- If you are feeling ill, have been in contact with an unwell person, or travelling please **stay home**.
- We are encouraging walking when possible as we will be using more power carts than usual.
- Threatening weather: Play not allowed during threat of bad weather, players are required to shelter in their vehicles.
- Kitchen is closed for now; beverages/snacks will be available.
- Beverage cart will not be operating for now – you are welcome to bring **empty** cooler bags if needed. We cannot provide cooler bags at this time.
- Golfing is optional; if you are uncomfortable being in public or our practices please **stay home**.

Booking Tee-Times

- Right now, we are not able to accept walk ons. Please call for a tee-time. (Note: we cannot accept bookings through social media or email) 519-443-0589
- Payment options: Visa, Mastercard, debit – please avoid cash payments when possible

Power Carts

- 2 carts max. for each foursome
- If you are not from the same household, 1 cart per person (max. 2 per foursome, we just do not have enough carts to accommodate more)
- Garbage must be removed once the round has ended – carts will be sanitized after each use.

The Game

- Stay a pin length apart from other groups & anyone not from your household.
- Do not remove the pin.
- Pin holes are blocked with a PVC pipe – once the golf ball hits the pipe, it is considered “in”.
- Do not shake hands or high five to celebrate. A tip of the cap will do.
